Market Animal and Heifer Premiums Each Ring

Ring A: Champion \$1,000, Reserve \$750, 3rd Overall \$500, 4th Overall \$250, 5th Overall \$100

Class Premiums

1st - \$60, 2nd - \$30, 3rd - \$20. Classes with less than 5 head will be prorated.

Other Information

- Entry fees \$60 for one ring, \$115 for both rings. \$5 discount for cattle nominated in the BEST program.
- Steer and market heifers born on or after 1/1/22
- Breed heifers born on or after 9/1/21
- Steers, market heifers, and crossbred heifers shown by weight
- Breed heifers shown by age. Registration required for all breed cattle.
- All cattle must have legible tattoos the first time through the chute. If the tattoos are not legible then the animal will be placed in the crossbred division
- Health papers required for all out-of-state cattle
- Show is open to the world
