THE DETAILS



The council and its programs will be open to all Ohio youth 8 to 21 years of age - no beef industry background required.



OBYC is not a show cattle program. It will provide unique programs for all youth including beginning 4-Hers, FFA students and college students who share a passion to learn more about the beef cattle industry.



No membership fee is required to be involved in OYBC - educational contests and events will have registration fees.



The council and its programs will align with the missions of OCA and the beef checkoff program.



OBYC will be directed by a 12-person leadership team that serves two-year, staggered terms Team members must be 16-years-of-age as of Jan. 1 and will be selected by an application and interview process each spring. Officer positions will be filled by team members serving their second year.
